

Laings Church of Christ

More about Laings' mission as a church..

The mission of the Laings Church of Christ is to offer eternal life to all people. Jesus states in John 10:10, "...I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly."

- * **Life** - John 10:10, refers to the spiritual life which Christ gives to all people who are willing to obey Him in faith. In reading the Bible, one can see that spiritual life begins when one has obeyed Christ's commands for salvation (Mark 16:16 and Acts 2:38), which then is seen in a transformed life (Ephesians 4:8).
- * **Involvement**- Each Christian is then encouraged to live a faithful Christian life through being involved in the work of the church (James 1:22). The strength of the congregation depends on how well each Christian functions in the body.
- * **Fellowship**- This involvement results in fellowship. We have fellowship with Christ and fellow Christians (1 John 1:7). We act out this fellowship by worshipping, serving, eating together, and making the most of every opportunity we have to get to know the Lord and each other (Acts 2:42-47).
- * **Evangelism**- Part of the Christian life is also telling others about it. We want to share the love of Jesus with everyone (Matthew. 28:18-20). This is done by inviting others to discover who the Savior is and how to have a relationship with Him. We do this by hosting gospel meetings, Bible school, free Bible correspondence studies and weekly preaching.


