The God We Worship by J.D. Conley

God Is The Object Of Our Worship. We are to “...serve [Him] acceptably with reverence and godly fear: For our God is a consuming fire” (Heb.12:28b -29, cf. also Ps.89:7). God seeks sincere spiritual worshippers, (Jn.4:23-24). May we never forget worship is a profound privilege which should never be taken lightly. The tendency today is to be casual and shallow in our religious assemblies. Yet, it is also the practice of some to be formal and outwardly pious, but inwardly unconcerned. Both types of worshippers fail to worship as Jesus teaches, and therefore they miss the mark entirely.

Worship Is To Be Related To God’s Nature. God is infinite in greatness, goodness and holiness, (Mt.6:9). He is the One in whom “we live, and move, and have our being” (Acts 17:28). He is “*The King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God*” (1Tim.1:17). God is infinitely adorable and worshipful and every one needs grace to offer well-pleasing worship to Him, (Heb.12:28).

God Is Holy. This truth is affirmed over and over again in the Scriptures. (cf. Ps.99:5,9; Josh.24:19; Isa.6:1-3, 5; 57:15; Jn.17:11; Rev.4:8; 1Pet.1:16, etc.).

God Is Omnipresent. God is everywhere. All of Him is everywhere at the same time. Nothing is hidden from Him, (Ps.139:7-10). Samuel said, “*For the Lord seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the Lord looketh on the heart*” (1Sam.16:7). God is present, unseen but seeing. When we worship Him, He looks not alone on our pious posture, but into our hearts. If in our hearts there is only well-hidden luke-warmness, God knows it.

God Is Love. The Bible expresses this fact, (1Jn.4:8, 16). The Psalmist agrees, (cf.Ps.107:8, 15, 21, 32). May we see that the worship we offer is a holy endeavor and an awe-inspiring privilege!
